

The following describes more specifically entitlements of the return and reintegration assistance.

Temporary Accommodation:

Assistance to cover most pressing needs such as food supply, bed and hygienic kits, transport during reconstruction phase

Housing Support:

Depending on the scale of damage, house will be rehabilitated as per the existing standards to ensure a habitable dwelling.

Infrastructure Projects:

Small projects such as water, road and electricity projects to improve the living conditions in the communities

Food Assistance:

Supply with dry food for a period of six months as per the current standards.

Non-food Assistance:

Provision of furniture and household equipment as per the current standards

Return Transport Assistance:

Transport of persons and their belongings from place of displacement to their place of return

Income Generation Projects:

Provision of tailor-made grants to support income generation

Community-development projects:

Community-driven project identified, assessed and implemented through LAG to promote inter-ethnic cooperation and development

Inter-ethnic dialogue:

Support reconciliation among communities

The Return and Reintegration in Kosovo project (RRK II) supports the dignified return and reintegration of minority refugees and IDPs in the municipalities of Klinë/Klina, Ferizaj/Uroševac, Kastriot/Obilić and Rahovec/Orahovac. The project donors are the European Union and the Ministry of Communities and Return, with implementation by DRC and municipal authorities.

Overview and Expected Results

1. Authorities and relevant bodies in four selected municipalities have enhanced capacities in designing and implementing sustainable minority return and reintegration projects, promotion of minority rights and participation in the process.

2. Based on informed decision, facilitation of sustainable of 210 minority IDP/Refugee return and improvement of living conditions in their return locations.
